Celebrating 25 Years Keeping Jews Jewish

'EWS FOR JUDAISM INTERNATIONAL WAS founded in 1985 by a young rabbi with a vision and a mission. Jews for Jesus was active on street

corners and flooding the media with full page ads. Parents were discovering that their loved ones were becoming "Born Again" and fanatically preaching the Gospel to their families.

Rabbi Bentzion Kravitz's breadth of knowledge of Judaism and Christian proof-texts made him a recognized expert in the counter-missionary field. He dedicated himself to offering counseling to those in need and raising awareness throughout the community. He made his mark upon the Jewish community, in no small way because of his nonjudgmental respect and caring for Jews regardless of their affiliation. Rabbis of all denominations called upon him for advice and assistance.

What started out as Rabbi Kravitz working from his apartment, with his wife and young children as his support staff, quickly grew into what is today the only fully-staffed, full-time, international organization of its kind. The Los Angeles center moved into its first offices in 1987, and Jews for Judaism quickly expanded to include offices in Baltimore and Toronto, and later overseas.

From a one-page, hand-typed newsletter in 1985, its prolific publications now include 25 years of newsletters, more than 320,000 copies of *The Jewish* Response to Missionaries handbook published in seven languages, pamphlets and booklets in multiple languages,

student prep kits, DVDs, and awardwinning websites.

Over the years, Jews for Judaism, with extensive help from the Los Angeles Jewish Community Foundation,

developed many innovative and cuttingedge programs, including a unique outreach program for intermarried couples targeted by missionaries and the Be-True student initiative. Be-True (see page 4) is a new creative response to the latest trends in missionary activity that utilize the internet, chat rooms and peer-to-peer proselytizing to reach young vulnerable students.

With the support of thousands of generous and loyal donors, Jews FOR JUDAISM has reunited families, brought thousands of Jews back to their heritage, and educated hundreds of thousands, giving them the tools to stand firm in their faith. Jews FOR JUDAISM'S websites have received millions visitors, including non-Jews who often share their

A Mother's Call for Help

have always taken my Judaism and my children's Judaism for granted. After all, once you are born a Jew, you remain a Jew, even if you don't believe in God. I have learned, though, that you must never take your children's Judaism as a given.

The biggest shock of my life came when my adult son told me he started going to church, became baptized, and

believes in Jesus as the Messiah and his personal savior with all of his heart and soul. My first reaction was that he just had some bad information and I would straighten him out, but I quickly realized this was not a matter of whose theology is better or who can build a stronger case. My son is completely immersed in Evangelical Christianity and there is no way or no one to simply "talk him out of it."

While searching the internet for answers to his assertions about Jesus, I found the Jews for Judaism website. I read the online version of their Counter Missionary Handbook and felt it would be a wonderful resource for those of us struggling with my son's new beliefs. We are a close, loving family, but this has

been a huge challenge and a potentially very divisive situation.

I called the Jews for Judaism Hotline and spoke with a warm and caring woman who assured me that Rabbi Kravitz could help my family and me. I ordered five copies of the handbook and later in the week, I spoke with Rabbi Kravitz. His understanding of the situation, his thoughtful method of approach, his care and concern for my son as well as all the rest of the family, was truly a gift

Rabbi Kravitz has been in touch with my son. I wish I could say my son gave up his beliefs after his first conversation with Rabbi Kravitz, but of course, that is both unreasonable to expect and highly unlikely. What Rabbi Kravitz was able to do is get a sense of where my son's thinking is and establish some common ground for future conversations.

I called the JEWS FOR JUDAISM Hotline and spoke with a warm and caring woman who assured me that Rabbi Kravitz could help my family.

Jews for Judaism has helped me on many levels. First, the handbook gave me the answers I needed when confronted with the Evangelical Christians' "proof texts." It is not enough to say "Jews don't believe in Jesus." We need to know


WHY. And we need to know WHAT Jews do believe.

Second, having Rabbi Kravitz as a support for our family has been a godsend. Other rabbis have reacted in understandably disturbed ways, which is not helpful to an already disturbed parent. Rabbi Kravitz's ability to leave the emotions aside while showing much concern and love for my son and the rest of us, made it easier for us all. And knowing Rabbi Kravitz is out there ... that anyone struggling with how to accept this part of my son's life can call him ... and that he is there for me if anything arises ... gives us all peace of mind.

I wish organizations such as Jews for JUDAISM did not have to exist. However, with so much assimilation, and active missionary groups working to spread Chistianity to young and vulnerable Jewish men and women, Jews for Judaism is a valuable resource - one I hope you will never need. It is interesting that, as I tell my story, so many people are telling me their own stories of an aunt or cousin or parent who converted to Christianity from Judaism.

My happy ending right now is not that my son returned to Judaism, but that Rabbi Kravitz has established a relationship with him, is helping my family work through this, and is giving us hope that perhaps, in the future, with the help of Jews for Judaism, my son will return to his rightful faith.

he Jews for Judaism *Be-True* student initiative is expanding in scope and locations. Hundreds of students are participating in activities that include student conferences, social events, contests, a student friendly website, campus student reps and video conferencing.

Be-True was created to help students cope with the growing trend of peer-to-peer proselytizing on high school and college campuses. Our slogan, Empowering You to Make Critical Choices, says it all. Student surveys have established that there is an 85% chance someone will try to convert students to another religion or use pressure to influence their life decisions.

The unique approach of Be-True, with its message of critical thinking and

coping with peer pressure, has caught the attention of a variety of groups. Be-True recently received a grant from the Wells Fargo Foundation in recognition of its unique and broad approach.

Within the Jewish community, more than a dozen Hillels on campuses from

San Diego to Santa Barbara are partnering with Be-True. Other groups participating include the Jewish Student Unions (JSUs) at every high school in the Greater Los Angeles area, Chabad on Campus, USY, Camp Ramah, New Community Jewish High School, Shalhevet, Brandeis Collegiate Institute and the Shalom Institute. They are actively promoting the Be-True program and have referred individual students for counseling. Many of our campus representatives and student leaders have come from these groups.

The message is spreading - and going viral over the internet on Facebook and Twitter. Our newest student rep, Jeremy

Nagel, is a college student in Sydney, Australia. On a recent visit to Israel to become a certified Krav Maga instructor, Jeremy used the skills he learned from Be-True to counteract missionaries on Jerusalem's Ben Yehuda Street. He enlisted friends to become "human statues," frozen in place to draw attention away from a group of missionaries, and he distributed Jews for Judaism literature explaining the deceptive practices employed by missionaries who visit the "Holy Land."

US Military Puts a Stop to Covert Proselytizing

roselytizing in the United States military is strictly prohibited. In Iraq and Afghanistan, especially, this must be enforced to prevent criticism that the U.S. is embarked on a religious "Crusade" in its war against al Qaeda and the Taliban.

According to ABC News Chief Investigative Correspondent Brian Ross, proselytizing is, however, taking place and the U.S. military isn't happy. Missionary groups have even shipped New Testament bibles in Afghani to military installations in the war zone in the hope that soldiers will distribute them to the public.

On a much larger scale, proselytizing has been perpetrated by the Trijicon company via their \$660 million,

multi-year military contract to provide 1 million rifle sights to the U.S. Marine Corps and Army. Soldiers refer to them as "Jesus Rifles."

Engraved on the sights, as part of the serial number, are abbreviated secret

coded references to New Testament Bible passages. This practice began under Trijicon's founder, Glyn Bindon, a devout Christian who included New Testament passages from John, Matthew and Corinthians, each referring to Jesus as "the light of the world." The coded serial numbers look like this: ACO64X23**JN8:12**, referring to John: Chapter 8, verse 12.

Once discovered, the Department of Justice demanded that the practice

be rectified and Trijion has agreed to voluntarily stop its policy and remove bible references that already exist.

We can learn an important lesson from this incident. Although freedom of religion is protected by the Constitution, there are appropriate controls and limits to proselytizing. The military draws its line based on its guidelines and Judaism does too. We draw the line when the proselytizing is unwelcome, deceptive or manipulative.

The challenges of missionaries targeting the Jewish community are constantly evolving. Today, in Israel, we are confronting an unprecedented growth of Jews for Jesus and "Messianic Jews." According to Israeli news investigations, they number more than 20,000 strong and are fighting for recognition as a legitimate expression of Judaism. In an attempt to win over public opinion they intentionally avoid mention of their belief in the divinity of Jesus. They cry "religious persecution" to gain the sympathy of secular Israelis unfamiliar with their tactics, and to rally evangelical Christians whose financial support of Israel puts them in a powerful position to pressure the Israeli government on the messianics' behalf.

Jews for Judaism is partnering with activists in Israel, and the Hebrew version of *The Jewish Response to Missionaries* is being distributed in print and as a free download.

We hope you will join us as we celebrate our 25th year and look forward to the future. The highlight of our celebration – a Gala Banquet following the High Holidays – will honor Jews for Judaism's founder and executive director, Rabbi Bentzion Kravitz, along with some of the outstanding supporters who have helped Jews for Judaism empower the Jewish community to keep Jews Jewish.
